


### Small Jaws Use Ranae






## Medium Jaws



# **Safety Precautions**



- Always read the instructions carefully before using the tool This tool kit is for compressing MacPherson shock absorber coil springs ONLY
- Always ensure tool installation on spring is securely connected before compressing
- Always fasten the jaws securely on tool body before compressing
- DO NOT face the tool top when operating (Fig. 1 & 2)
- Always keep at least 30cm (1 foot) away fromt the tool when operating (Fig. 3 & 4)
- Ensure the working area has adequate lighting
- Keep children and unauthorized person away from the working area
- Keep working area clean and tidy, dry and free from unrelated materials
- DO NOT allow untrained persons to use this tool kit
- Always wear eye protection that meets OSHA and ANSI Z87.1 standards
- Always wear gloves when working with the tool
- Always wear ear protection
- Disposal: Customers should follow local regulations or entrust local organization to handle used/wasted parts




- Choose a suitable pair of jaws.
- Put protection covers on the jaws.
- Connect the jaws securely to the tool body by using the fasteners provided.
- Use an **extension bracket** if needed.
- Mount the tool onto the spring. Turn the nut on tool body to adjust the length.
- 6. Make sure the tool is securely mounted on the spring. Use a spanner, or air wrench to turn the nut to compress the spring.



### **Protection Covers**

The protection covers can protect the paint on coil springs from being scratched. The covers are consumable items. Please contact your local sales agent or distributor for purchasing new covers.



### **Extension Bracket**

The extension bracket can be mounted between tool body and the jaw. This bracket is used when compressing a conical shaped coil springs.
